

LICENSE AGREEMENT FOR USE OF THE FEARNLEY PROCTER NS-2™ LOGO AND/OR TRADEMARK

ADDENDUM 8

Additional Restrictions for use of the Logo and Trademark in Exhibitions and displays.

This Addendum, along with other addenda, is an integral part of the attached license agreement and should not be treated otherwise. Any restrictions of use for the LOGO and the TRADEMARK should be considered in addition to, and not in replacement of, any restrictions in the main agreement. Guidance notes that are given are to assist the licensee in complying with the license. The licensee should note that the licensor reserves the right to reject any use of the Logo or the Trademark for any reason.

The guidance notes in this addendum are meant for items particular to exhibitions.

Promotional items used at exhibitions, including but not limited to brochures, flyers, video displays, slide shows and computer programmes and displays are covered in other addenda or in the main agreement.

For the sake of this addendum the items that shall be included are:

1. Exhibition display panels
2. Posters
3. Give-aways and other promotional items

Exhibition display panels

The logo and the trademark may be used on display panels. Care should be taken to ensure that the references required for the logo and the trademark should be readable from the front of the stand and in a font size not less than 20 point.

Choice of background colour is important to ensure that the logo and the trademark are easy to see.

Please remember that neither the logo nor the trademark should be larger than those of the APPROVED or of the licensee and that they should always be kept in their supplied proportion.

Posters

Posters are considered promotional items and should comply with all aspects of the license agreement.

Give-aways and other promotional items

If the licensee wishes to use the logo or the trademark on a 'give-away' or a 'promotional item' then due to the diverse range of items it is recommended that they contact the licensor prior to use for approval .
